The above statistics are figures for the ward and therefore include incidents on Kings Park and Kingsmere, Sovereign Harbour (Inc Crumbles Retail Park) and Langney Point.

The Burglary occurred on Sovereign Harbour, but was later proven to have not occurred.

The Sovereign Harbour and Langney Point have suffered an increase in theft from and theft of motor vehicles. A single group is believed to be operating in the area. Any information will be greatly received.

Violent Crime includes incidents of Domestic Violence. The number of Domestic Violence incidents that contribute to these statistics is unknown.

There have been a number of incidents of Criminal Damage reported on Kingsmere relating to the new play areas. We believe that some of the persons responsible are from outside the area; there is an investigation into an unrelated matter, but we believe that the persons responsible for the damage may be linked. However, at this time there is a lack of evidence to support further investigation/ prosecution.

Neighbourhood Priorities

Drugs

- Positive warrant executed in Kingsmere. Cannabis seized and occupants arrested for possession of cannabis.
- There have been fewer sightings of 'London Steve' believed to have moved out of the area.
- High vis patrols continue in Rockhall Avenue to deter related activity.

Problems associated with speeding vehicles, anti-social driving and parking

- Roads Policing Unit are undertaking regular road safety checks on A259 Pevensey Road. This is known as Op Vortex.
- A number of local residents have been stopped and advised re their speed.

Dangerous Cycling

- Regular high-vis patrols are deterring dangerous cycling and there are few reports of incidents made to PCSO Holland.

Areas patrolled by PCSO as part of directed patrol

Patrols have been undertaken by PCSO Hollands in the Kingsmere and Kings Park area. In particular, attention has been paid to Herward Road (ASB) and Rockhall Avenue (Drugs). PCSO Holland has completed approximately 100 patrol hours in the area since the last neighbourhood panel meeting.
